Overview

In 2018, HUG launched a first of its kind evaluation tool, the Sports Tourism Index^{TM}. The Index provides a numerical measurement of where a sports tourism destination stands at any given point in time. HUG can use the Index' data to rank and rate one destination against its competitive set.

In 2020, HUG began building a business development tool within the Index. This new functionality, called Scout, launched on January 5, 2021. Over 350 CVBs and sports commissions have already signed up to use the Index and the Scout option and there is significant interest across the country.

The addition of the Index + Sout platforms have positively enhanced the consulting work of HUG to the point that the organization has developed a new position specific to leading consulting projects. This position, the **Director of Special Projects**, is a full-time remote position whose key responsibility is to manage and lead strategic planning projects and facility feasibility studies for the destinations we serve.

This position provides an opportunity for an energetic young professional to lead an established brand through a period of high organizational growth in the expanding sports tourism and events industry.

- Serve as the primary lead on all consulting projects.
- Work with the HUG data analytics team to integrate data points into all consulting projects and their recommendations.
